KEEPING OUR PTSA GOING STRONG

As our PTSA starts putting things into place for next year to be successful, we are in need of a few volunteers to come forward to keep things rolling smoothly. Many of our elected board members (3 of the 4) and committee chair volunteers are moving up to Kentlake next year.

Five years ago, volunteer support at the school was so low that key enrichment programs were being cut. 7th graders were no longer able to participate in the frog dissection lab, there were only three soccer balls in P.E. that held air, and teachers were spending up to \$350/year out of their own pocket on needed supplies.

Over the past few years, the PTSA has worked very hard to revitalize the support and provide funding for these programs. Our PTSA brought back the Frog Dissection lab, Ice Cream making lab, purchased new calculators for Math, paid for Scholastic News and Scope publications for Language Arts, provided funding to help redo the teachers lounge, provided mini-grants to each department for classroom supplies and providing funding for each department to purchase basic supplies such as printer toner cartridges. In the 2016-2017 school year, we also donated funds to support Multicultural Night and purchased robots for the STEM class.

Many of us, including myself, are looking forward to summer vacations and taking a bit of a break from thinking about school for awhile, but it is imperative for us to set things up for next year in order for our PTSA to continue in a successful manner. Please consider being a vital role in your child's journey through middle school. Parent involvement in school activities drops significantly at the middle school level, even though it's needed more than ever.

We want the momentum and progress of the PTSA to continue! For next year, we need to fill three final board positions along with other chair positions in order for our progress to keep going.
